Here is some important information for the new Academic Year 2024 - 2025

- **School attendance is compulsory.** We will follow up any non-attendance immediately through either Seesaw or telephone. Please make sure your child



attends school every day unless they are ill. ***On no account am I allowed to authorise 'Holidays' unless there are exceptional circumstances.*** Parents will need to set out the exceptional circumstances in a letter to me, as Headteacher, at least 6 weeks prior to any leave of absence being requested. There are strict new guidelines for attendance that come into being on August 19th. There is no longer an authorised code for holidays. I am hopeful that a letter from the Local Authority will be sent out before the end of term to let parents know of the changes and their implications.

- **Larks and Owls** will resume in September to support working parents. Please remember to book your child's place in advance. Larks and Owls gets very busy and places may have to be limited.
- **News on Larks opening times** – We have decided to open Breakfast Club from 7.30 am following some requests from parents. Please contact school as soon as possible to let us know if you wish your child/children to attend this earlier session. There will be additional charges and we will get these to you as soon as possible (hopefully by the end of the week)
- All pupils will be expected to wear full school uniform **unless it is their class PE day** in which case they will need to come to school in their **School PE uniform**. Please could you ensure your child has the correct **PE uniform** for September. This is available to purchase through Identity.
- Start and finish times for each class will remain staggered to ensure our school site does not get regularly too overcrowded. This helps all children, particularly those with SEND, come into school in a calmer and more settled manner, ready to begin their learning promptly.
- Your child's new class teacher will communicate with you (through Seesaw/email) any essential information before the beginning of the next academic year.
- Resources and equipment will be provided for each child to use. **Please do not send your child to school with any pencil cases, toys or other items from home.** Children just need their school book bag and a refillable water bottle containing water only please.
- Parental queries and concerns can be emailed or telephoned through to the School Office or Class Teacher. You can also communicate with class teachers through Seesaw.
- **Safeguarding Note:** No Parents or Carers will be permitted to enter the school premises/building **without an appointment**.

Finally, have a lovely Summer Break – when it eventually arrives! Enjoy family time together and cherish the memories you will make.
